Aix-en-Provence is studded with hundreds of sparkling fountains and is known for its art, food, and Baroque architecture.

The University of Arizona partners with the Institute for American Universities to provide you with a study abroad experience that lets you choose from a range of courses for your major, minor, general education, and elective requirements. Students are required to take at least one French language course while at UA Aixen-Provence in the Fall, Spring, or Academic Year terms, but you will have an assortment of levels to choose from. Whether you are a beginner or already have French language proficiency, this program is for everyone! Additionally, you'll pay your regular UArizona tuition and be able to use your financial aid, including AZ Excellence and Wildcat Excellence Awards in the fall and spring semesters!
