SUBJECT: In Support of Visa and Entry to the U.S.

The purpose of this letter is to assist University of Arizona international students with the visa and entry process for a successful and timely start to their academic experience. We request your assistance with the following:

- 1. That students and their dependents be granted a visa interview or appointment for obtaining or renewing an F-1 or J-1 visa, if otherwise eligible.
- 2. That students and their dependents be granted an expedited visa interview or appointment, if otherwise eligible.
- 3. That students and their dependents be allowed entry to the U.S., if otherwise eligible.

Classes begin on the date indicated on students' I-20/DS-2019. Students are expected to enroll in in-person coursework, with no more than 3 units or 1 class of online coursework counting towards full-time enrollment requirements.
