At UA Florence, hosted by the Institute for American Universities, you may choose from a variety of courses to satisfy your degree requirements, with the approval of your advisor. The best part is, you'll pay your regular University of Arizona tuition and can use your scholarships and financial aid, like **AZ Excellence** and **Wildcat Excellence awards**! The Eller College of Management recommends participating in the UA Florence program during the second semester of your upper division program, after you have been professionally admitted to your major. For the summer program, you are eligible to complete upper division business courses abroad after you have been professionally admitted to your major. Spring professional admission applicants are conditionally approved to complete these courses. Remember, every student is on a different path towards graduation so the best way to plan for studying abroad is to work directly with your Eller global advisor to discuss which courses will be best for your academic and professional goals. Course availability varies and can be subject to change.
