Eller major students are eligible to enroll in upper-division business courses abroad after you have been professionally admitted to your major. Work directly with an Eller Global Advisor to discuss which courses will be best for your academic and professional goals. Eller minor students, please be advised that a minimum of nine units must be completed in residence, nine units must be upper division, and any transfer coursework must be approved through the Eller College Undergraduate Programs Office.
