At UA Athens, hosted by the American College of Greece, you may choose from a variety of courses to satisfy your degree requirements, including general education, with the approval of your academic advisor. The best part is, you'll pay your regular University of Arizona tuition and can use your scholarships and financial aid, like **AZ Excellence** and **Wildcat Excellence awards**!

For business major students, the Eller College of Management recommends participating in the UA Athens program during the second semester of your upper-division program, after you have been professionally admitted to your major. Keep in mind that every student's path to graduation is different, so the best way to plan for studying abroad is to work directly with your Eller Global advisor to determine which courses align with your academic and professional goals.

For business minor students, the Eller College of Management recommends completing all lower-division business minor courses before taking upper-division business courses. However, there are no strict prerequisites while you are abroad. A minimum of nine units must be completed in residence (at the University of Arizona); nine units must be upper-division, and any transfer coursework must be approved in advance through the Eller College Undergraduate Programs Office. Please contact the Eller College Business Administration minor advisor with questions.

Course availability varies by semester and may be subject to change. Refer to the program webpage for current offerings.
