At UA London, hosted by St. Mary's University, you can choose from a variety of courses to satisfy your degree requirements, including general education with the approval of your academic advisor. To make choosing courses easier, faculty in the College of Medicine preapproved courses to satisfy many of your Medicine major requirements. The best part is, you'll pay your regular University of Arizona tuition and can use financial aid and scholarships, including **AZ Excellence** and **Wildcat Excellence** awards! Course availability varies per term and can be subject to change.
