At UA Sydney, hosted by the University of Technology Sydney, you can choose from a variety of courses to satisfy your degree requirements, including general education with the approval of your academic advisor. To make choosing courses easier, faculty in the School of Animal and Comparative Biomedical Science preapproved courses to satisfy many of your Veterinary Science requirements. Veterinary Science majors may apply up to 9 credits and minors may apply up to 6 credits from these preapproved lists to satisfy program requirements.

The best part is, you'll pay your regular University of Arizona tuition and can use financial aid and scholarships, including **AZ Excellence** and **Wildcat Excellence** awards!
