3. Have you completed at least 120 total credits towards your U of A degree? (You can view this total on the UA Advisement Report on UAccess Student)
4. Have you completed 42 upper division credits (300-400 level) towards your U of A degree? (You can view this total on the U of A Advisement Report on UAccess Student)
5. Have you completed 30 residence credits towards your U of A degree? (Applicable courses are in **red** below. You can determine completion in Course History in UAccess Student)
6. Is your final **cumulative** U of A GPA a minimum of 2.0? (You can view this GPA on the U of A Advisement Report on UAccess Student. It will comprise of the courses in **red** listed below)
