CURRICULUM

DEGREE SEEKING ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS

Category	Requirement
Application	Submit online application
Transcripts	Submit official transcripts in English from any universities with all available grades
GPA	2.00 cumulative GPA (includes UA & NKU coursework)
English Proficiency	C or higher in ENGL 107/108; or 100 CEPT; or 100 Duolingo; or 70 TOEFL; or 6.0 IELTS

Degree seeking applications will be submitted in 2 years during Term 5.

ENGLISH PROFICIENCY



1. Pre-Term 1: Earn B1 or higher on entrance English exam



2. Terms 1 & 2: Intensive English preparation at NKU



3. Pre-Term 3: Earn B2 or higher on English exam

- Do not need to take if already earned a B2 or higher in 1st attempt



4. Terms 3-5: English courses at U of A

You must earn a D or higher in each English course to move through the sequence. However, you must also maintain a 2.00 overall UA GPA to remain in the program.

Failure to complete all English courses by the end of Term 6 may result in dismissal from the program!

Dear Future Wildcat,

TASKS

Once you receive your admittance email from U of A:

1. Set up NetID and Password.
2. Download and set up account with Duo Mobile app.
3. Create NetID+ account and register devices.
4. Attempt to login to a U of A resource (UAccess Student Center) to verify login credentials work.

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5. Login to Catmail through Outlook to check email. Check this every day!
 6. Complete your Next Steps Center tasks.
 7. Login to D2L and begin participating in U of A courses.

NETID & PASSWORD



1. Go to <https://netid-portal.iam.arizona.edu/>
2. Select and read netid creation guidelines
3. Select "Create UA NetID"
4. Enter your UA SID (8 digit number), Date of Birth and Pin #
5. Create your NetID
6. Create your password / passphrase
7. Create a hint to help you if you forget your password
8. Select "Proceed without enabling the NetID Passcode service"
9. Complete agreement and submit

DUO MOBILE & NETID+

1. Install Duo Mobile app on your smartphone
2. Go to <https://netid-plus.arizona.edu/> and log in with your NETID & Password
3. Select "Sign up for NETID+"
4. Answer the security questions
5. Scroll down to the "Add a Device" section
6. Select "Add a Smartphone"



DUO MOBILE & NETID+

7. Choose your platform from the dropdown list and select "Continue"
8. Enter a name for your phone and click "Continue"
9. Enter your phone number; check the box labeled "Please check to confirm your phone number" and select "Continue"
10. The system sends a verification code to your phone via text message
11. Enter the verification code and select "Continue"
12. **A success message with a QR code confirms your registration; you will use this code to activate Duo Mobile**

DUO MOBILE & NETID+

If you are using a computer:

1. Open the Duo Mobile app
2. Tap "Continue"
3. Tap "Use QR code"
4. Tap "Allow" to give Duo Mobile access to your camera
5. Use your smartphone to scan the barcode on your computer screen to activate your account
6. Tap "Next" when Duo prompts you to name your account; Duo inserts University of Arizona as the name on your account
7. Tap "Save"

If you are using a phone:

1. Select the FIRST link that is included in the success message
2. The system sends a prompt to open the Duo Mobile app; select "Open"
3. Tap the prompt to activate your account
4. Duo inserts University of Arizona as the name on your account
5. Tap "Save"

DUO MOBILE & NETID+



Let's test that it's working!

1. Go to studentcenter.arizona.edu which is your Student Portal
2. Enter your NETID & Password and select "Login"
3. You are directed to check your device for a Duo push notification (make sure notification banners from Duo are turned on in your phone settings)
4. Either select "Approve" from the banner, or go to the app directly and select "Approve"
 - Only approve if it is you – if you are not attempting to login, select "Deny" and change your UA password immediately

DUO MOBILE & NETID+

5. Confirm if you own this device
 - Select “Yes, this is my device” if you own the device and other people do not use it
 - Select “No, other people use this device” if you are using a public or shared device
6. Confirm if you want to trust this browser for 30 days
 - Check the box if “Yes” – recommended for private devices (this will lessen the amount of times you have to enter your login credentials)
 - Leave the box blank if “No” – recommended for public or shared devices
7. Select “Continue to application”
8. You have successfully logged into your UAccess Student Center!
